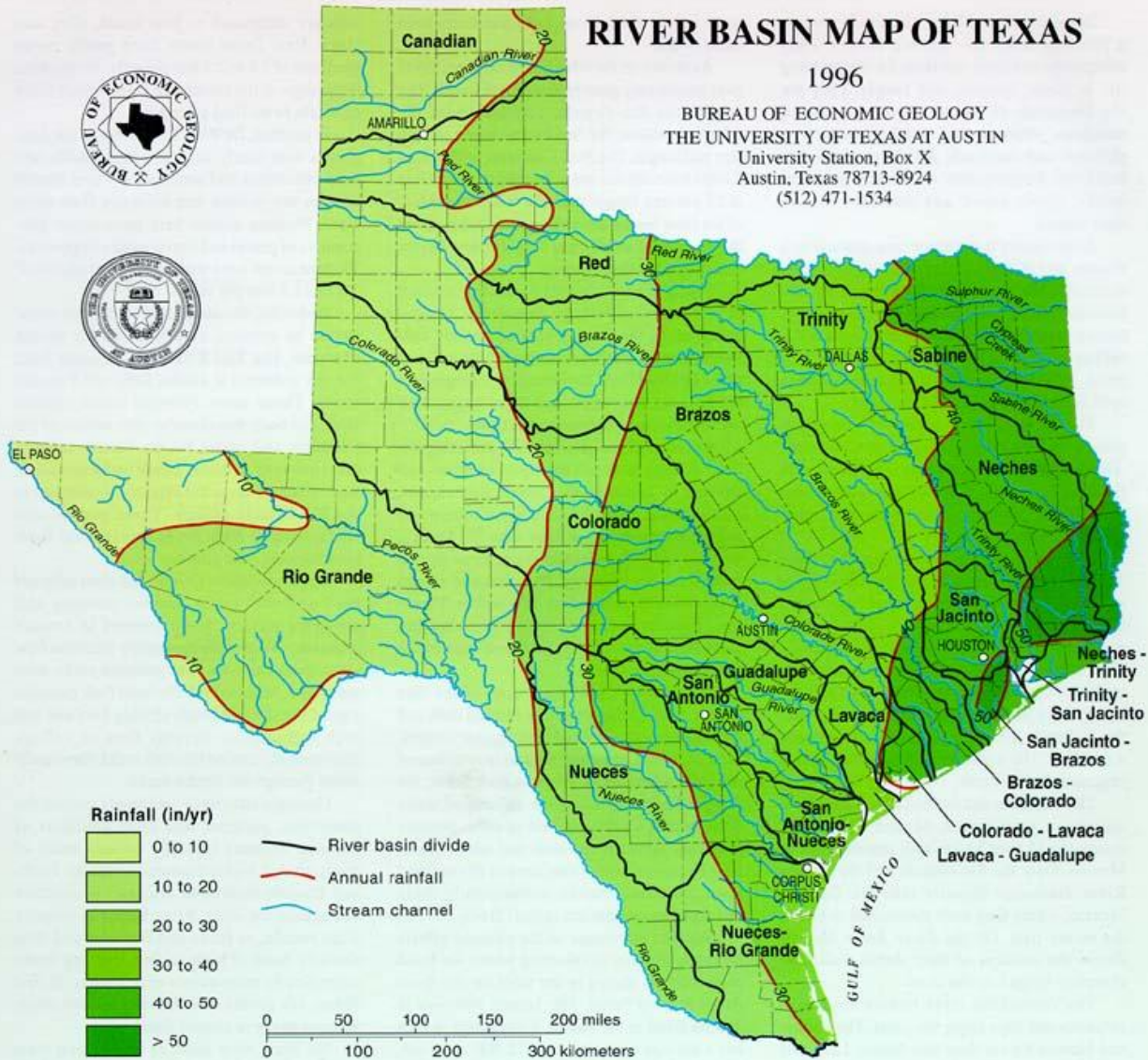


RIVER BASIN MAP OF TEXAS
